# Green Mountain Spinnery's Knitters' Weekend

Greetings! Here's the latest information on our 20th Annual Knitters in the Green Mountains Weekend: Friday, November 5 to Sunday, November 7, 2010 in Putney, Vermont. Our weekend begins Friday evening with dinner featuring locally grown produce.

Our featured teacher is designer Alison Green Will. Alison has been teaching knitting for 10 years and is an accomplished designer. Her works can be seen at <a href="https://www.alisongreenwill.com">www.alisongreenwill.com</a> and in the wildly popular online knitting magazine <a href="https://www.alisongreenwill.com">Twist Collective</a>, where she is also a technical editor.

The topics this weekend focus on expanding basic skills to the next level so that you can confidently try new things or experiment with adapting patterns, yarns and design.

The workshops are:

## Math for Knitters

Don't be intimidated by the title; in this workshop you will learn how to perform all the calculations necessary to create basic sweater designs (along with other garments/accessories), as well as to change existing patterns. For example, if you wanted to substitute yarn of a slightly different gauge or alter specific design elements in the pattern, this class will provide those tools. Fit and measurements will also be discussed so that you can be sure your knitting will work for you.

## Continental Knitting

Knitting "continental" style is where you hold the yarn in your left hand, "picking" the yarn rather than having to "throw" or wind the yarn all the way around with your right hand. Many knitters find that it is faster once they get used to it, as it requires a lot less hand movement. We'll play around with different ways of holding the yarn and also explore "combined" knitting, which uses some Eastern techniques of winding the yarn in the opposite direction on the purl stitches.
