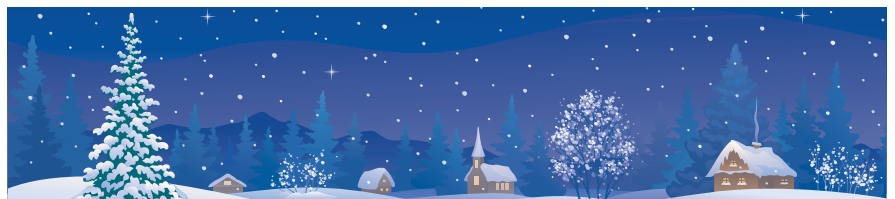

Unwashed skeins will “bloom” to softness if gently hand washed before knitting. Easy washing instructions are included with your order. Note: Odd weight skeins are first quality, but the yarn is, overall, a bit lighter or heavier than in a regular weight skein. When we fill orders for any particular color, all the skeins will be either all heavies or all lights. Check your gauge carefully before starting your project.

MOUNTAIN MOHAIR

70% Wool / 30% Yearling Mohair

Vibrant and subtle hues with a frosty sheen, pure beauty! We blend the softest yearling mohair with fine wool and spin it into a single ply yarn that wears beautifully.

Irving Berlin is credited with composing Ragtime music and lyrics that were uncomplicated, simple and direct, with his stated aim being to "reach the heart of the average American." We think that this delightfully straightforward poncho does the same. The pattern is created with an easily memorized pattern that will have you singing along in no time.



THE ZEN SHAWL

One musician's false note can be the inspiration for another's new melody. This shawl's interplay of textured colors and stitches create a complex visual fabric that is easy to knit. This little shawlette allows you to go with the flow instead of fretting over the details of exacting lace. Dive into this pattern without worrying about tinking back stitches or missed yo's; your shawl's imperfections make it a unique work of art.



SUSPENSION SHAWL

The twisted ribs of this shawl fashion vertical cables anchored by a symmetrical sweep of diagonal spokes for a perfectly balanced interplay of structure. This shawl's unusual construction allows you to build a light weight and comfortably pliable shawl to your preferred dimensions, resulting in a classic accessory that will always be in style.



KNOTWEED WRAP

Japanese Knotweed is a New England invasive that can grow over a dozen feet in a season. We think that you'll find this delicate wrap expands almost as quickly. The easily memorized four row lace pattern combines with the playful change of color to be found in Spinnery Ragg-Time skeins to make for a project you won't want to put down!

Kristen designs classic sweaters with unique construction. There are some simple garter/rib panels worked along each raglan, with increases to each side. The rest of the sweater is knit in easy Stockinette stitch with a little broken ribbing at the edges.
